Good day everyone: I would like to remind everyone of the C-NLOPB's request for comments on the proposed amendment, attached again for convenience, from BP Canada Energy Group ULC.

The amendment has been submitted in support of bp's request to include the following activities not previously assessed:

1. The deployment and retrieval of transponders and marker buoys via remotely operated vehicle for positioning of an exploration drilling unit;

- 2. The deployment and retrieval of moorings for physical environment monitoring using moored monitoring instruments;
- 3. Seabed monitoring and sampling; and
- 4. Environmental (Coral and Sponge) monitoring and sampling.

To accommodate environmental monitoring, bp is proposing to amend the temporal scope to include activities from March to October. Activities were originally assessed to occur from May to October.
