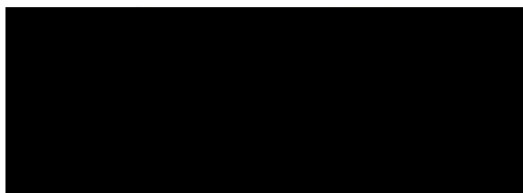

BP Canada Energy Group ULC has reviewed the comments submitted to the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board (C-NLOPB) during review of the Ephesus Prospect ROV Survey, 2019-2024 Environmental Assessment. We understand the requirement to address submitted comments in order to satisfy the requirements of the *Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Atlantic Accord Implementation Act* and the *Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Atlantic Accord Implementation Newfoundland and Labrador Act* and to enable the C-NLOPB to make a determination at the conclusion of the assessment.

BP acknowledges comments received from Environment and Climate Change Canada (ECCC) which includes a revalidation of comments submitted to the C-NLOPB on 31 January 2019, as well as a recommendation for data collection from the Canadian Wildlife Service (CWS). Previously submitted comments from ECCC were taken into consideration during the development of the Environmental Assessment Report and will also be taken into consideration during project planning and execution. BP will also follow up with ECCC-CWS to learn more about the use of the Eastern Canada Seabirds at Sea (ECSAS) mobile database to facilitate the entry and storage of migratory bird data collected during the Project.
