

Exploration Geophysicist

The Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board (C-NLOPB) is the independent regulator of offshore oil and gas activity off the coasts of Newfoundland and Labrador, on behalf of the federal and provincial governments. Created in 1986 through the Atlantic Accord and its implementing legislation, the C-NLOPB provides regulatory oversight of operator activities in the areas of health and safety, environmental protection, resource management and Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador benefits. The C-NLOPB invites applications for the position of **Exploration Geophysicist**.

The **Exploration Geophysicist** will be a member of the Exploration and Information Resources Department. Reporting to the Exploration Geoscience Lead, this position will:

- Evaluate and interpret 2D and 3D seismic data
- Participate in geophysical studies and special projects related to exploration geosciences
- Conduct geophysical interpretation in support of land tenure assessments
- Administer regulations and guidelines for exploration related approvals and authorizations; monitor operators activities for compliance with approvals; and communicate with operators with respect to compliance
- Participate in drafting and review of exploration related policies, guidance and other regulatory instruments
- Provide geophysical advice and support to other Board Departments
- Liaise with oil and gas companies, external stakeholders and consultants
- Other related duties assigned as required

Qualified applicants have at least five years experience in the oil and gas industry and possess a bachelor's degree or higher in geology or geophysics. The ideal candidate has a strong understanding of sedimentary geological processes with a focus on oil and gas geophysical analyses. Experience with 2D/3D seismic data interpretation and knowledge of advance geophysical techniques is essential. Eligibility for registration with the Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of Newfoundland and Labrador (PEGNL) is required.
