## RE: Proposed Expansion of Project Area

Dear Ms. Young:

Corridor wishes to advise the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board (C-NLOPB) that Corridor proposes to expand the temporal and spatial extents of the geohazard project area, purely for the purpose of examining the environmental impacts of potential future geohazard surveys within an expanded project area. Additional geohazard surveys could be expected over the next ten years depending on the results of the first exploratory well. Corridor could anticipate up to eight additional geohazard surveys to be acquired during open water periods of the year in the expanded project area during the remainder of the EL1105 License period (2013) and potentially beyond (2020).

The expanded project area will comprise the northern part of EL1105 and a narrow strip of land immediately adjacent to, and to the west of EL1105. The limits of the proposed expanded project area are shown in Schedule 'A'. Note the expanded project area includes an 'Affected Area' to accommodate vessel turning while acquiring geohazard surveys. Depending on the location of any given geohazard survey, the survey may require authorization from either the C-NLOPB or the National Energy Board, or both.
