Corridor Resources Inc. (Corridor) and its consultant, Stantec, have prepared a Concordance Table to highlight the modifications that have been made to the Old Harry Environmental Assessment (EA) to address the issues arising from the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board (C-NLOPB) Completeness Review. The Concordance Table and associated attachments are appended to this letter. The final EA submission incorporates these updates.

In response to your request to provide the C-NLOPB the report entitled *Genesis of Reservoir Hydrocarbons and Migration of Oil and Gas within Old Harry Prospect: Two Dimensional Petroleum System Modeling Using 2-D Seismic Lines (98-23-K50 and 98-32)* (Mukhopadhyay, P.K. 2011), Corridor has transmitted the report with this letter to the C-NLOPB for its internal review. However, it is important to note that Corridor considers this document to be privileged and confidential and therefore not for public dissemination. The applicable information from this report justifying the type of oil likely to be produced from the Old Harry structure has been incorporated into the final EA document.
