As requested, the Department of National Defence (DND) has reviewed the report entitled "Environmental Assessment of the Old Harry Prospect Exploration Drilling Program" (Stantec, 2011) and its supporting documents, as provided to DND by the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board (CNLOPB) in a letter dated 22 December 2011 and later revised on 12 January 2012.

The following was observed during the review:

- The first part of the first sentence in section 5.8,2.6 of the report is not accurate. DND may use the general area;
- b. The context in which the figure is referred to in the text is not accurate i.e. the figure does not indicate "military use", it indicates UXO;
- FSE does not have a record of providing this figure to the agency for this
 project, therefore; its proper source should be referenced; and
- d. The mitigation section of the report should note that should any suspected UXO be encountered during the course of the proponent's operations, it should not be disturbed/manipulated. The proponent should mark the location and immediately inform the Coast Guard. Additional information is available in the 2011 Annual Edition - Notices to Mariners, Section F, No.37.
