

**1. DND is likely to be operating in the vicinity of the study area in a non-interference manner during the 2012 to 2014 timeframe.**

**2. A search of the UXO records was conducted to determine the possible presence of UXO within the Corridor Resources Exploration Well on the Old Harry Project.**

**Our records indicate no wrecks are present within the survey area.**

**Given our understanding of the survey activities to be conducted, the associated UXO risk is assessed as negligible. Nonetheless, due to the inherent dangers associated with UXO and the fact that the Atlantic Ocean was exposed to many naval engagements during WWII, should any suspected UXO be encountered during the course of Statoil's operations, it should not be disturbed/manipulated.
