Re: Corridor Resources Inc. Exploratory Drilling Program on the Old Harry Prospect, Exploration Licence 1105, 2012 to 2014 CEA Act Environmental Assessment

In accordance with the Canadian Environmental Assessment Act (CEAA) and based on the information presented in the project description "Project Description for the Drilling of an Exploratory Well on the Old Harry Prospect – EL 1105" (Corridor Resources Inc. February 2011), the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board (C-NLOPB) has determined that a screening level of environmental assessment is required for the proposed offshore drilling program.

The C-NLOPB has determined the scope of the project, the factors to be assessed, and the scope of those factors (the Scoping Document). A copy of the Scoping Document is attached for your information and use in preparation of the environmental assessment report. Please note, as stated on page 2 of the Scoping Document,

The C-NLOPB has determined that the environmental assessment report and any supporting documents to be submitted by Corridor Resources Inc. will fulfill the requirements of a Screening under the CEAA. The C-NLOPB, therefore, pursuant to Section 17 (1) of the CEAA, formally delegates the responsibility for preparation of an acceptable Screening environmental assessment to Corridor Resources Inc., the project proponent. The C-NLOPB will prepare the Screening Report, which will include the determination of significance.
