Re: Electromagnetic Geoservices Canada Inc. - Environmental Assessment East Canada Controlled Source Electromagnetic Survey, 2014 to 2018

The Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board (C-NLOPB), in consultation with the Board's fishery and environmental review agencies, has reviewed the environmental assessment (EA) amendment report "Environmental Assessment East Canada CSEM Survey, 2014-2018 Amendment" (LGL Limited November 21, 2014). The report is an amendment to the Environmental Assessment East Canada CSEM Survey 2014-2018 (LGL Limited March 2014) and the Environmental Assessment East Canada CSEM Survey, 2014-2018 Addendum (LGL Limited July 2, 2014). The "Environmental Assessment East Canada CSEM Survey, 2014-2018 Amendment" (LGL Limited November 21, 2014) was been submitted in support of EMGS's request to extend the temporal scope of their geophysical project by one month from November 30, 2014 to December 31, 2014.

The EA Amendment report provides a satisfactory assessment of environmental effects associated with this activity. The C-NLOPB is of the opinion that, taking into account the implementation of mitigation measures committed to by Electromagnetic Geoservices Canada Inc. during the environmental assessment, the project is not likely to cause significant adverse environmental effects.
