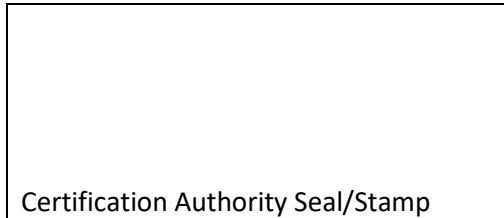
1. The installation, including associated equipment described above:
