Good afternoon Darren,

Further to comments documented in Addendum #2 of this program's EA we have consulted with Fugro regarding the use of Fisheries Liaison Officers onboard both program vessels. (The One Ocean Risk Management Matrix Guidelines were discussed. It was explained that this matrix was not created with this type of exploration program in mind).

While the program area has been since revised (see area outlined in white on the attached map, pink section was the previously proposed area), **it is still the FFAW's recommendation that the program employ Fisheries Liaison Officers (FLOs) onboard both program vessels.**

More than half of the area of interest for this project extends beyond the 200 mile limit where we have limited information on the current level of fishing activity. The use of FLOs on similar exploration programs in the past has been an effective mitigation measure to facilitate at-sea communication between ocean users and to prevent at-sea conflicts.

Unfortunately, Fugro is of the viewpoint that the use of FLOs is not needed for their program.

We will await a CNLOPB decision on the matter.
