Re: EA Amendment - GX Technology Canada Ltd. 2D Seismic, Gravity and Magnetic Survey for the Labrador Shelf Area, 2013 to 2015

On March 15, 2016, GX Technology Canada Ltd. (GXT) submitted to the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board (C-NLOPB) an amendment "*GX Technology Canada Ltd.'s LabradorSPAN 2D Seismic, Gravity and Magnetic Survey Environmental Assessment Amendment*" (March 2016) to the environmental assessment (EA) report and addendum for the 2D, gravity and magnetic program for the Labrador Shelf Area in the Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore. The enclosed report is an amendment to the March 2013 "*Environmental Assessment of GXT's LabradorSPAN 2-D Seismic, Gravity and Magnetic Survey, 2013-2015*", the July 2013 "*Environmental Assessment of GXT's LabradorSPAN 2-D Seismic, Gravity and Magnetic Survey, 2013-2015 Responses to Environmental Assessment Review Comments*" and the July 2013 request to extend streamer length. The 2016 EA Amendment addresses changes in the project scope that were originally assessed in 2013. In particular, a request to amend the temporal scope to 2020 and increase the potential maximum annual production to 16,000 line kilometres.

The C-NLOPB requests that you review the enclosed EA Amendment and provide comments no later than **April 13, 2016**. If no response is received by this date, the C-NLOPB will assume that no comments will be submitted.
