In accordance with Section 138(1)(b) of the Canada-Newfoundland Atlantic Accord Implementation Act and Section 134(1)(b) of the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Atlantic Accord Implementation Newfoundland and Labrador Act and based on the information presented in the project description "GXT 2013-2015Marine 2D Seismic, Gravity and Magnetic Survey Project Description) (GX Technology Canada Ltd. January 2013), the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board (C-NLOPB) has determined that an environmental assessment is required for the proposed offshore program.
