Darren:

Further to your June 12, 2017 email requesting review of the “Hebron Project Environmental Assessment Amendment June 2017” describing the planned discharge of SBM drill cuttings with cement that was not included within the original project Comprehensive Study Report (CSR).

Based on the information presented the planned discharge of SBM drill cuttings with cement does not appear to change the impact predictions provided for within the project CSR given that: the SBM cement cuttings estimated to be discharged is relatively small when compared to the total WBM associated drill cuttings estimated to be released; based on updated modelling the majority of the SBM cement cuttings are predicted to settle within the footprint of the WBM cuttings and the predicted extent of such cuttings deposition has not changed significantly with the addition of the SBM cement cuttings; the project footprint remains at least 50 km from any sensitive or special marine areas; the cement additives appear to be allowed to be discharged under the OWTG; the SBMs continue to have low toxicity; and the project EEM program will include sampling that will be reflective of the amended project design.
