As discussed, the approvals and permits that WRMD would issue for this project are mainly related to the site infrastructure and construction of the dry dock. At this stage there has been limited information provided in this document to outline the site infrastructure requirements for this project. In addition, this may be the responsibility of Nalcor as they are the owners of the site. I have therefore listed below a general list of permits/approvals which may be required by WRMD for site infrastructure and construction of the dry dock:

The proponent will require approval from this Division under Section 39 of the Water Resources Act for the proposed development within Protected Water Supply Areas.

The proponent must obtain a permit under Sections 36 & 37 of the Water Resources Act prior to the start of construction.

Contact: Manager, Surface Water Section (709) 729-2535

The proponent must apply for a non-domestic drilled well permit under Section 58 of the Water Resources Act for the proposed drilled well(s)

Contact: Manager, Groundwater Section (709) 729-2939.

The proponent must obtain a Water Use License from this Division for the non-domestic use of water.

Contact: Manager, Water Rights Section (709) 729-4795

The proponent will require approval from this Division under Section 48 of the Water Resources Act before starting construction activities within 15 metres of any water body (including wetlands). Construction activities include all stream crossings, drainage works, fording and any other work such as landscaping, clearing or cutting of any natural vegetation within 15 metres of a body of water.

Any effluent or runoff leaving the site will be required to conform to the requirements of the Environmental Control Water and Sewage Regulations, 2003.
