**Re: Hebron Project Comprehensive Study Report - Response to Review Comments, Part I**


ExxonMobil Canada Properties (EMCP) is submitting the enclosed responses to the comments received from the C-NLOPB on April 20, 2011 regarding the review of the **Hebron Project Comprehensive Study Report: Response to Review Comments Part I, March 18, 2011.**

We note, in particular, that further comments were provided regarding the re-injection of water-based drilling fluid (WBDF) and related cuttings and the feasibility of produced water re-injection (PWRI). As stated in our enclosed responses, we believe that the environmental assessment provided in the CSR adequately assesses the residual environmental impacts from these discharges. We believe that the CSR and the Response Documents provide sufficient information to support the conclusions of no significant residual environmental effects associated with these discharges.
