Subject: Revised 2017 Hebron – Environmental Assessment (EA) Amendment to the September 2011 Hebron Project Comprehensive Study Report (CSR)

Dear Ms. Young:

In accordance with communication received from the Environmental Affairs staff based on outside agency review of the previously submitted December 2017 EA Amendment to the September 2011 Hebron Project Comprehensive Study Report (CSR), please find attached the revised EA Amendment.

The December 2017 EA Amendment described and assessed a proposed modification to the Project as compared to that which was originally assessed, approved and implemented pursuant to EA review and approval process. In particular, the planned modification related to an increased discharge of total residual chlorine in order to maintain operational integrity of critical platform drilling and safety systems.

As requested the only revision required relative to the original submission is the addition of wording clarifying that there is no regulatory limit of 2ppm for total residual chlorine in cooling water discharge prescribed in the *Offshore Waste Treatment Guidelines* (2010)
