Response to Review Comments from Natural Resources Canada

Natural Resources Canada (NRCan) has provided the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board (C-NLOPB) with their response to the request to review ExxonMobil Canada Properties (EMCP) May 13, 2011 response to NRCan's April 6, 2011 review comments on the "*Hebron Project Comprehensive Study Report*" (June 2010). NRCan have stated that, in general, the responses are considered satisfactory and have provided the following comment for your consideration.

13.4.3 Tides, Water Levels, and Storm Surge - *A global tsunami warning system can be subscribed to through <http://wcatwc.arh.noaa.gov/watcher/tsunamiwatcher.php>, but NRCan's experts agree that the proponent should replace this by a service from the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador when it is available from them.*
