Further to your May 9 email and request please note that the above noted EA Amendment describing proposed temporal extension from 2016 to 2020 and planned change in drilling practices does not change the original predictions of no significant effect on fish/fish habitat related VECs assessed in the Drill Centre EA. Mitigation measures committed to in the Drill Centre EA remain applicable and will continue to be implemented.

That being said there is confusion concerning the number of wells drilled to date. Information provided in Section 1.0 Introduction (page 3) states that ""There were a total of 54 wells proposed for these five drill centres, but only 13 have been drilled to date. 10 wells have been drilled at NADC and 3 at SWRX", Section 2.0 (page 4) indicates that "To date, Husky has completed 10 wells at NADC (from 2010 to 2014) and 3 at SWRX. Husky estimates 1 additional well is required at NADC and up to 8 wells at SWRX from 2016 to 2020" appears to be different that the information presented in Section 4.0 (page 8) which indicates that "To date, there have been only 11 wells drilled in two drill centres. An additional 11 wells are planned in two existing drill centres to the end of 2020."

The depiction of wells drilled and wells remaining to be drilled seems to be contradictory and should be clarified.
