The Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board (C-NLOPB), in consultation with the Board's fishery and environmental review agencies, has reviewed Husky Energy's (Husky's) environmental assessment (EA) amendment report "Amendment to the Husky White Rose Drill Centre Environmental Assessment" (Husky Energy June 13, 2016). The report is an amendment to the "Husky White Rose Development Project: New Drill Centre Construction and Operations Program Environmental Assessment" (LGL Limited September 2006), the addendum (LGL Limited January 2007) and supplementary information. The amendment was submitted in support of Husky's request to extend the scope for drilling activity from 2015 to 2020 within the North Amethyst and South White Rose Extension drill centres.

The EA Amendment report provides a satisfactory assessment of environmental effects associated with this activity. The C-NLOPB is of the opinion that, taking into account the implementation of mitigation measures committed to by Husky during the environmental assessment, the project is not likely to cause significant adverse environmental effects.
