Re: Husky White Rose Development Project New Drill Centre Construction and Operations Program Environmental Assessment Amendment: Construction of Protective Flowline Rock Berms

The Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board (C-NLOPB), in consultation with the Board's fishery and environmental review agencies, has reviewed the environmental assessment (EA) report "*Husky White Rose Development Project New Drill Centre Construction and Operations Program Environmental Assessment Amendment: Construction of Protective Flowline Rock Berms*" (April 15, 2009).
