One Ocean has reviewed the EA Report for the above referenced project and comments are as follows:

As the liaison organization for the fishing and petroleum industries in Newfoundland and Labrador, it is our responsibility to ensure and facilitate effective communication and consultation between the two industry sectors. One Ocean did participate in a consultation(s) with Husky Energy on this proposed project and because of the time frame (2008-2017) formally requested that Husky provide One Ocean and the Fish, Food and Allied Workers (FFAW) union, with applicable updates/information regarding scheduled activities.

Commercial Fisheries data has been documented in several Husky Reports for this region. Again, because of the time frame to 2017, it is imperative that fish and fish habitat in the project area is actively monitored. If there is a change in commercial fisheries species, as previously experienced in this province, active data collection and compilation would be most useful in future consultations.

One Ocean has accessed drilling information (history) from the C-NLOPB website; however the information available only covers up to 2003. One Ocean shall make a formal request to the C-NLOPB to have this information updated but takes this opportunity to make the C-NLOPB and the proponent aware of its importance.
