Section 3.0 Potential Effects of the Sound Velocity Sensor Acoustic Emissions and ROTV Presence on the Environment. Migratory birds (particularly diving birds) and Species at Risk should be considered and discussed in the effects assessment, in a similar fashion to how fish, marine mammals, and marine reptiles have been discussed.
