On February 27, 2012, Husky Energy (Husky) submitted to the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board (C-NLOPB) an environmental assessment report for proposed 2D and/or 3D seismic surveys, vertical seismic profiles (VSPs) and geohazard surveys in the Jeanne d’Arc Basin/Flemish Pass area from 2012 through 2020 in the Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore. Husky anticipates carrying out one or more 2D and/or 3D seismic surveys and at least three well site geohazard surveys, with the possibility of two to four between 1 March and 30 November, 2012. The enclosed report “*Environmental Assessment of Husky’s Jeanne d’Arc Basin/Flemish Pass Regional Seismic Program, 2012-2020*” describes these activities for this area. The C-NLOPB is conducting a screening, pursuant to the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act* (CEA Act), of the proposed Project.

The environmental assessment report was completed in accordance with the scoping document prepared by the C-NLOPB on December 20, 2011.
