Some observations on the responses to comments which were forwarded on Monday March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2015.

Within Amendment:

- Upon looking at table 3.1 again, there is reference to "fish migration routes change or catchability decreases". FFAW-Unifor would suggest that the consideration should be: Potential loss of income to resource users due to change fish behaviour and spatial distribution. Not all species are migratory, so the existing text is not encompassing everything.

In the Consultation Report:

- The name of one of the FFAW-Unifor staff is Robyn Saunders and not Robynn Saunders
- There are references to the "DFO end of season crab survey", proper reference on this would be *Industry-DFO Collaborative Post-Season Trap Survey for Snow Crab*.
