Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the proposed MKI seismic program Project Description (PD) and Scoping Document.  
The CNSOPB offers the following comments for your consideration:

\* Page 5 of the PD confirms that data will be not be acquired within the CNSOPB jurisdiction; it is stated that ship turning and streamer deployment will all be within C-NLOPB jurisdiction, therefore, no activity authorization is required from the CNSOPB.

\* The study area for the EA, however, does include a small amount of the CNSOPB jurisdictional area adjacent to the Boards' jurisdictional boundary divisor line.

The CNSOPB is in possession of specialist and expert information/knowledge that can be provided to support the assessment of the potential for sound propagation from the proposed program to affect species, habitats and/or other ocean users within the CNSOPB jurisdictional area.
