As requested Fisheries Protection Program (FPP) has reviewed the above noted Amendment to the Environmental Assessment of MKI's Southern Grand Banks Seismic Program, 2014-2018 covering the proposed conduct of 3D seismic surveys win the program EA Study area.

The description of the potential residual effects for the 3D Seismic program on fish, fish habitat, and fisheries appears to be satisfactory and essentially the same as that described for the 2D program in the original 2014 EA (and related amendments). With respect to the description of measures to mitigate potential effects on fish, fish habitat and fisheries.
