- Table 4.13 (page 124) Atlantic salmon should be listed as separate populations with their respective COSEWIC status
  - While the response provided in the Addendum is acceptable in the interest of clarity it is felt that footnotes should be added to each respective COSEWIC status noting which populations of Atlantic Salmon are considered Endangered, Threatened and/or Special Concern accordingly. This information is available from the COSEWIC website and may be added at the bottom of the table.
