

DANGEROUS SITUATION ORDER

(Pursuant to section 205.093 of the *Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Atlantic Accord Implementation Act* and section 201.90 of the *Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Atlantic Accord Implementation Newfoundland and Labrador Act* respectively)

Issued to: Suncor Energy Inc.

Whereas Suncor Energy Inc. is the Operator of the *Terra Nova FPSO* pursuant to Production Operations Authorization No. 23020-020-0A06 issued on October 4, 2017;

And Whereas, the Chief Safety Officer is of the opinion that there is a risk of serious bodily injury or fatality, when a worker conducts confined space work in accordance with current Suncor procedures and policies which are not in accordance with sections 160 and 161 of the Canada–Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Marine Installations and Structures Occupational Health and Safety Transitional Regulations.

Therefore, it is hereby Ordered by the Chief Safety Officer that the Operator immediately cease all confined space work and that all confined space work procedures and policies be reviewed and updated for compliance with regulatory requirements in accordance with sections 160 and 161 of the Canada–Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Marine Installations and Structures Occupational Health and Safety Transitional Regulations and to ensure worker safety at or near the Terra Nova FPSO.

It is further Ordered that the Operator provide a copy of this Dangerous Situation Order to the Workplace Committee and post it in the Permit to Work Office on the *Terra Nova FPSO*.
