

WHITE ROSE DEVELOPMENT PLAN AMENDMENT APPLICATION

CANADA-NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR OFFSHORE PETROLEUM BOARD

DECISION REPORT 2013.04

The Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Petroleum Board (the Board) met on April 26, 2013 to consider the following:

- White Rose Development Plan Amendment South White Rose Extension Tieback (January 15, 2013); and
- Concept Safety Assessment of South White Rose Extension Project.

The Board was guided in its deliberation by a staff analysis of the Application.

The Board hereby approves the White Rose Development Plan amendment (South White Rose Extension Tie-back) subject to the following conditions:

- 2013.04.01 The Proponent must submit a report acceptable to the Board assessing the sealing nature of the fault separating the East and West Fault blocks one year after commencement of gas injection into the southern Terrace.
- 2013.04.02 Should the period of gas injection prior to oil production in the SWRX Pool extend beyond 18 months, the Proponent must submit a report acceptable to the Board detailing the activities to date and future plans for gas injection in the SWRX Pool.
