

DANGEROUS SITUATION ORDER

(Pursuant to section 205.093 of the *Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Atlantic Accord Implementation Act* and section 201.90 of the *Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Atlantic Accord Implementation Newfoundland and Labrador Act* respectively)

Issued to: Suncor Energy Inc.

Whereas Suncor Energy Inc. is the Operator of the *Terra Nova FPSO* pursuant to Production Operations Authorization No. 23020-020-OA06 issued on October 4, 2017;

And Whereas, the Chief Safety Officer is of the opinion that there is a risk of serious bodily injury or fatality from any fall from a vertical ladder that is greater than 6 metres in length between safe working levels where (a) the ladder is not protected by a protective cage OR (b) in the absence of a protective cage, when a worker is not provided with a fall protection system in accordance with sections 10 and 176 of the Canada–Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Marine Installations and Structures Occupational Health and Safety Transitional Regulations.

Therefore, it is hereby Ordered by the Chief Safety Officer that the Operator immediately take all measures to ensure the use a fall protection system for all vertical ladders greater than 6 metres in length that are not fitted with a protective cage at or near the *Terra Nova FPSO*.

For clarity, vertical ladder length is from safe working level to safe working level. In determining the ladder length for compliance with this Order, any landings or platforms installed at required intervals in accordance with Sections 10 and 176 of the Canada—Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Marine Installations and Structures Occupational Health and Safety Transitional Regulations do not shorten the ladder length.

It is further Ordered that the Operator provide a copy of this Dangerous Situation Order to the Workplace Committee and post it in the Permit to Work Office on the *Terra Nova FPSO*.
