<b>Key Questions/Issues Raised</b>	<p><b>Interested in</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Marine Atlas and GIS platform</li> <li>2. Participation in TAG (Technical Advisory Group)</li> <li>3. In terms of Regional Assessment (RA) GIS, Bryn suggested that if the data was not clipped to the RA then there could be a broader application of the information beyond the RA and in fact clipping the data is an extra step.</li> <li>4. Better communication—example was given that Donna checks CEA Agency website regularly but would be easier to receive notification. Consider notification for projects within the RA.</li> <li>5. Recent Indigenous Knowledge interviews with Stantec using Google Earth.</li> </ol> <p><b>Concerns</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>6. Insufficient capacity and expertise in environmental assessment reviews</li> <li>7. Priority for review are effects on migratory species like salmon and birds</li> </ol> <p><b>Information</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>8. NCC fishes 12 species on communal licences like salmon, cod, whelk, seals, etc inshore and nearshore</li> <li>9. Commercial fisheries through Nunacor and Rod Coombs for shrimp and crab. Likely in 2J, maybe 3K and maybe others.</li> </ol>
