


Regulatory Roadmap - Use of Regulations Respecting Excluded Physical Activities (Newfoundland Labrador Offshore Exploratory Wells) (Post Operations Authorization)



Assumptions:

- For Conditions requiring consultation with Indigenous Groups and commercial fishers, the Operator is required for conducting that consultation.
- For Conditions requiring consultation with other Federal departments, the C-NLOPB will contact those departments on behalf of the Operator.
- Timelines provided are estimate and are informed by previous experience in conducting compliance monitoring and verification of CEAA 2012 Decision

- The Ministerial Condition will be incorporated by the C-NLOPB as a condition of their

- 2. Compliance monitoring and verification may include an onsite visit to the drilling installation during the drilling program

 - Results of marine mammal and sea turtle monitoring (within 90 days, section)
 - Results of underwater sound monitoring (within 90 days, section 6c)
 - Results of migratory bird follow up monitoring program (within 90 days)
