## **Decision:**

The Chief Safety Officer accepts the Applicant's, the owner of the West Hercules, request for an exemption to use the following standards for the design of the Emergency Electrical Power and Emergency Shutdown System which permits a self-contained battery system to supply power automatically to the internal communications systems for thirty minutes on power failure or shutdown in lieu of the *Newfoundland Offshore Petroleum Installations Regulations* requirements 12(3)(b)(ii), 18(1) & 18(5) for the self-contained battery system to supply power automatically to the internal communications systems for one hour on power failure or shutdown:

- DNV-OS-A101 Safety Principles and Arrangements (October 2002);
- DNV -OS-D101 Marine and Machinery Systems and Equipment (April 2003);
- > DNV-OS-D201 Electrical Installations (April 2005); and
- IMO MODU Code 1989 (with amendments to 2001)
