**Decision:**

The Chief Safety Officer accepts the Applicants, the owner of the *M/V Siem Daya 1*, proposal to use *GL Rules and Guidelines* and *International Maritime Organization MSC/Circ.982 Guidelines on Criteria for Bridge Equipment and Layout* in lieu of the regulation requirements for bridge lighting levels specified in Part 6 of the *Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Marine Installations and Structures Occupational Health and Safety Transitional Regulations*.

This substitution is effective from the date herein until the *Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Marine Installations and Structures Occupational Health and Safety Transitional Regulations* are repealed or that any representations made in the application for substitution has changed, whichever is earlier. For greater certainty, exemptions from part III.1 Regulations made pursuant to the Accords Acts will no longer be granted after December 31, 2019.
