The Chief Safety Officer does not concur with the Applicant's proposal to use the HPTSS suit, which conform to the CGSB 65-17-2010 helicopter suit standard, in lieu of the Canada—Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Marine Installations and Structures Transitional Regulations and the Newfoundland Offshore Petroleum Installations Regulations requirement to use immersion suits which conforms to the National Standard of Canada CAN/CGSB-65.16-M89, Marine Abandonment Immersion Suit Systems.
