
Regulation: *Section 34 of the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Marine Installations and Structures Occupational Health and Safety Transitional Regulations*

Decision:

The Chief Safety Officer accepts the Applicant's, the owner of the MV Calamity Jane, proposal to use of the following internationally recognized standards for elevating devices in lieu of the Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Marine Installations and Structures Occupational Health and Safety Transitional regulations requirements:

- *NEN 1082 Safety Requirements for Service Lifts (Dutch Standard)*
- *NEN 3585 Safety Requirements for immobile material hoists (Dutch standard);*
- *EU Directive 95/16/CE– Approximation of the laws of member states relating to lifts;*
- *NEN – EN 81-3 – Safety Rules for the construction and installation of lifts – Electric and Hydraulic service lifts;*
- *NEN – EN 81-31 - Safety Rules for the construction and installation of lifts - Lifts for the transport of goods only; and*
- *ISO 8383 – Lifts on ships, specific requirements.*

This substitution is effective from the date herein until the *Canada–Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Marine Installations and Structures Occupational Health and Safety Transitional Regulations* are repealed or that any representations made in the application for substitution has changed, whichever is earlier. For greater certainty, exemptions from part III.1 Regulations made pursuant to the Accords Acts will no longer be granted after December 31, 2019.
