

Decision:

The Chief Safety Officer accepts the Applicant's, the owner of the *M/V WG Amazon Conqueror*, use of *British Standards BS EN 12413:2007+A1:2001 – Safety Requirements for Bonded Abrasive Products, BS ISO 525:2013 – Bonded Abrasive Products: General Requirements* in lieu of the *Canada – Newfoundland and Labrador Marine Installations and Structures Occupational Health and Safety Transitional Regulations* requirement which specifies the use of Abrasive Wheels that meet the requirements of ANSI Standard B7.1-2010.

This substitution is effective from the date herein until the *Canada – Newfoundland and Labrador Marine Installations and Structures Occupational Health and Safety Transitional Regulations* are repealed or that any representations made in the application for substitution has changed, whichever is earlier. For greater certainty, exemptions from Part III.1 Regulations made pursuant to the *Accords Acts* will no longer be granted after December 31, 2019.
