Decision:

The Chief Safety Officer authorizes the Applicant, the owner of the M/V Seven Waves, to use and maintain the fixed fall protection system in accordance with *EN 358 Personal Protective Equipment for work positioning and prevention of falls from height- Belts for work positioning and restraint and work positioning lanyards, EN 355 Personal Protective Equipment against falls from height: energy absorbers, and EN 361 Personal Protective Equipment against falls from height, full body harnesses in lieu of CSA Standard Z259.1-05, Body Belts and Saddles For Work Positioning and Travel Restraint, published in 2010; CSA Standard Z259.11-05, Energy Absorbers and Lanyards Published in 2010; and CSA Standard Z259.10-12 Full Body Harnesses, published in 2012.*

This substitution is effective from the date herein until the *Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Marine Installations and Structures Occupational Health and Safety Transitional Regulations* are repealed or that any representations made in the application for substitution has changed, whichever is earlier. For greater certainty, exemptions from Part III.1 Regulations made pursuant to the *Accords Acts* will no longer be granted after December 31, 2019.
