**Decision:**

The Chief Safety Officer authorizes the Applicant, *Technip Canada Limited*, to use and maintain loose lifting equipment in accordance with *Lifting Operations and Lifting Equipment Regulations (LOLER 1998)* onboard the *M/V CSO Wellservicer* in lieu of the requirement in the *Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Marine Installations and Structures Occupational Health and Safety Transitional Regulations* to use loose lifting equipment that meets ASME B30.9-2010 and ASME B30.26-2010.

This substitution is effective from the date herein until the *Canada – Newfoundland and Labrador Marine Installations and Structures Occupational Health and Safety Transitional Regulations* are repealed or that any representations made in the application for substitution has changed, whichever is earlier. For greater certainty, exemptions from Part III.1 Regulations made pursuant to the *Accords Acts* will no longer be granted after December 31, 2019.
