Decision:

The Chief Safety Officer accepts the Applicant's, the owner of the *R/V Coriolis II*, use of the *Maritime Labour Convention, 2006, Title 3, Regulation 3.2 – Food and Catering, Maritime Occupational Health and Safety Regulations Section 80 to 85 (Preparation, Handling, Storage and Serving of Food), and Maritime Personnel Regulations Section 329 (Food and Water)* in lieu of the *Canada – Newfoundland and Labrador Marine Installations and Structures Occupational Health and Safety Transitional Regulations* requirement which specifies the use of Section G of the “*Sanitation Code for Canada’s Foodservice Industry 1984*”.

This substitution is effective from the date herein until the *Canada – Newfoundland and Labrador Marine Installations and Structures Occupational Health and Safety Transitional Regulations* are repealed or that any representations made in the application for substitution has changed, whichever is earlier. For greater certainty, exemptions from Part III.1 Regulations made pursuant to the *Accords Acts* will no longer be granted after December 31, 2019.
