**Decision:**

The Chief Safety Officer accepts the Applicant's, the owner of the *MV Seven Falcon*, use of the protective footwear that is certified in accordance with the *ISO Standard 20345:2011 Personal protective equipment - Safety footwear* in lieu of the requirement in the *Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Marine Installation and Structures Occupational Health and Safety Transitional Regulations* to use the *CSA Z195-09 Standard*.

This substitution is effective from the date herein until the *Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Marine Installations and Structures Occupational Health and Safety Transitional Regulations Section 171* are repealed or that any representations made in the application for substitution has changed, whichever is earlier. For greater certainty, exemptions from part III.1 Regulations made pursuant to the *Accords Acts* will no longer be granted after December 31, 2019.
