Decision:

The Chief Safety Officer concurs with the Applicant's, the operator of the Hibernia Installation, proposal to use a piece of material handling equipment (Combilift C8000XL) that has been approved and certified to the International Electrotechnical Commission System for Certification to Standards Relating to Equipment for use in Explosive Atmospheres (IEC Ex) and the ATEX directive, in lieu of the American Petroleum Institute RP 14F, Recommended Practice for Design and Installation of Electrical Systems for Offshore Production Platforms." The following condition applies:

1. The material handling equipment is only used in hazardous areas for which it is suitably rated.
