Decision:

The Chief Safety Officer accepts the Applicant's, the operator of the Searose FPSO, proposal for completion of Hot Work to repair porous weld between 2 center void and 2 starboard Cargo Oil Tank (COT) during normal operations, provided all risk reduction measures outlined in the Application are followed. The Application is approved subject to the following conditions:

- 1. All expectations addressed in the associated C-NLOPB Hot Work Interpretation Note 14-01 apply to this RQF decision and where required, Husky's Permit to Work System shall reflect these expectations.
- 2. All safeguards listed by Husky as well as the recommendations outlined by the 3rd party review are strictly adhered to.
- 3. There shall be no intrusive maintenance work on topside hydrocarbon systems while hotwork is conducted.
