**Decision:**

The Chief Safety Officer accepts the Applicant's, the owner of the *MV Fugro Discovery*, use of portable electrical tools that meet the requirements of applicable European Commission (EC) directives in lieu of the amended *Canada – Newfoundland and Labrador Marine Installations and Structures Occupational Health and Safety Transitional Regulations* requirement which specifies the use of portable electrical tools that meet the requirements of CAN/CSA-C22.2 No 60745-2, ULC Standard 60745-2 and International Electrotechnical Commission Standard 60745-2.

This substitution is effective from the date herein until the amended *Canada – Newfoundland and Labrador Marine Installations and Structures Occupational Health and Safety Transitional Regulations* are repealed or that any representations made in the application for substitution has changed, whichever is earlier. For greater certainty, exemptions from Part III.1 Regulations made pursuant to the *Accords Acts* will no longer be granted after December 31, 2019.
