The Chief Safety Officer approves the Applicant's, the owner of the *Hebron Platform*, use of their Work Management System Best Practice (*CAHE-EC-OOREF-01-006-4001-000*) for confined space entry into Void Spaces in lieu of the requirements in Subsection 133(1)(d)(i and ii) and 133(2) of the *Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Occupational Health and Safety Regulations* which requires isolation methods to be in place before a person enters the confined space and certain engineering controls in place for pipes that contain a hazardous substance.
