Decision:

The Chief Safety Officer approves the Applicant's, the owner of the *Terra Nova FPSO*, use of the existing ladders for the topsides and turret modules that are approved by a Professional Engineer for ladder support spacing intervals greater than three metres and confirmed fit-for-purpose by the Certifying Authority. This approval is in lieu of the requirements of Subsection 101 (1)(b) of the Canada – Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Area Occupational Health and Safety Regulations that specifies that any fixed ladder is to be securely held in place at the top and bottom and at intervals of not more than 3 metres. This approval is subject to the following conditions:

- 1) Fixed ladders are inspected and maintained as fit for purpose as part of the Structural Integrity Management Program for the Terra Nova FPSO and included in annual general surveys to ensure continued in-service integrity.
- 2) Suncor is to follow industry best practice with respect to the safe use of ladders.
