The Chief Safety Officer approves the Applicant's, the owner of the <i>Hibernia Platform</i> , use of their Work Management System Best Practice (<i>HS-O-O-X-A00-XX-0604.008</i>) and Work Management System Addendum - Isolation of Piping OSH Regulation Requirements (<i>HS-O-O-X-A00-XX-0604.011</i>) for confined space entry into the non-hazardous open drains tank (F-501) in lieu of the requirements in Subsection 133(1)(d)(i and ii) and 133(2) of the <i>Canada-Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Occupational Health and Safety Regulations</i> , which requires isolation methods to be in place before a person enters the confined space and certain engineering controls in place for pipes that contain a hazardous substance.
