## **Decision:**

The Chief Safety Officer approves the Applicant's, the owner of the DSV Seven Falcon, use of DNVGL Rules for the Classification of Ships, Part 6, Chapter 8, Section 3.6, ladders and Subsea 7 Standard Operating Procedures with respect to ladders and stairs, in lieu of the requirements for ladders and stairs in Subsection 98(2), 101(1a), 101(1d), 101(1f), 101(1g) of the Canada–Newfoundland and Labrador Offshore Area Occupational Health and Safety Regulations subject to the following conditions:

- 1) *The Ladder aft of bottles in gas stores* is only to be used when specific tasks require it and hand carriage of tools is prohibited when using this ladder;
- 2) The *Ladder from bow to bridge deck* is to be for emergency use only;
- 3) The Outboard and Forward ROV hanger Ladders are to be used with fall protection;
- 4) Escape Hatches Ladders are to be used for emergency escape purposes only; and
- 5) All general and specific mitigations stated in the application for ladders must be kept in place while operating in the Offshore Newfoundland Area.
