Decision:

The Chief Safety Officer exempts the Applicant, the owner of the West Aquarius, from having airlock arrangements on external doors of the accommodations with the exception of the main deck entrances which have air-locks, provided Temporary Safe Refuge (TSR) integrity is tested every 36 months, the external doors meet DNV offshore standards and are maintained to prevent the passage of smoke and flame under normal atmospheric conditions and adequate spares are available for all accomodations external door types.
